GUIDELINES FOR GIFTS AND DONATIONS

The VA Center for Development & Civic Engagement (CDCE) manages the many gifts and donations provided by generous and caring donors wishing to support our Nation's Veterans. CDCE volunteers, community and civic groups, corporations, Veteran Service Organizations, and individuals are among the many contributors of monetary and in-kind donations to VA.

There are nearly as many ways for donors to support Veterans as there are ways to volunteer. The generosity of our donors provides supplemental resources necessary to support a variety of programs and services for Veterans and their families.

Benefits of Giving

When you give to VA, you are making a positive difference in a Veteran's life. Your support can help us better serve Veterans, and provide the resources that will help to improve the lives of ill and disabled Veterans.

Your Gift is Tax Deductible

Donations made to the VA are tax deductible according to the Federal Tax Code as "Donations to the United States", in the manner and to the extent allowable by law. (Note: The Internal Revenue Service (IRS) has special rules regarding the tax deductibility of contributions of \$250 or more). The VA ensures that all contributions are used efficiently and responsibly. 100% of every contribution goes directly to benefit Veterans and their families.

Planned Giving

Devises and bequests can be given to VA, and allow supporters to plan long-term gifts to help Veterans. Contact your CDCE office at your nearest VA facility. Through financial contributions to VA, you enable us to purchase the most urgently needed items that directly help support Veteran programs such as: transportation services; social service assistance; recreation programs and activities; temporary lodging for families of Veterans recovering in a health care facility; rehabilitation equipment; homeless Veterans services; comfort items; holiday gifts; phone cards; or provide other assistance as needed.



- -Make checks payable to the VA facility of choice; include designation of donation if applicable (specify purpose)
- Checks should never be made payable to "cash" or to an individual.
 A temporary receipt for funds will be provided and within 30 days, a Field Service Receipt and acknowledgement letter will be mailed.

In-Kind Donations

- -Good and Services, known as in-kind donations, can be very valuable in helping Veterans.
- -It is always helpful to include a listing of all the items donated to ensure proper credit for the donor group or organization.
- -CDCE staff can not place a dollar value on in-kind donations for tax purposes. Donor will receive an acknowledgement letter that describes the in-kind donation.
- -It is the responsibility of the donor to determine fair dollar value of their in-kind donation for IRS purposes,
